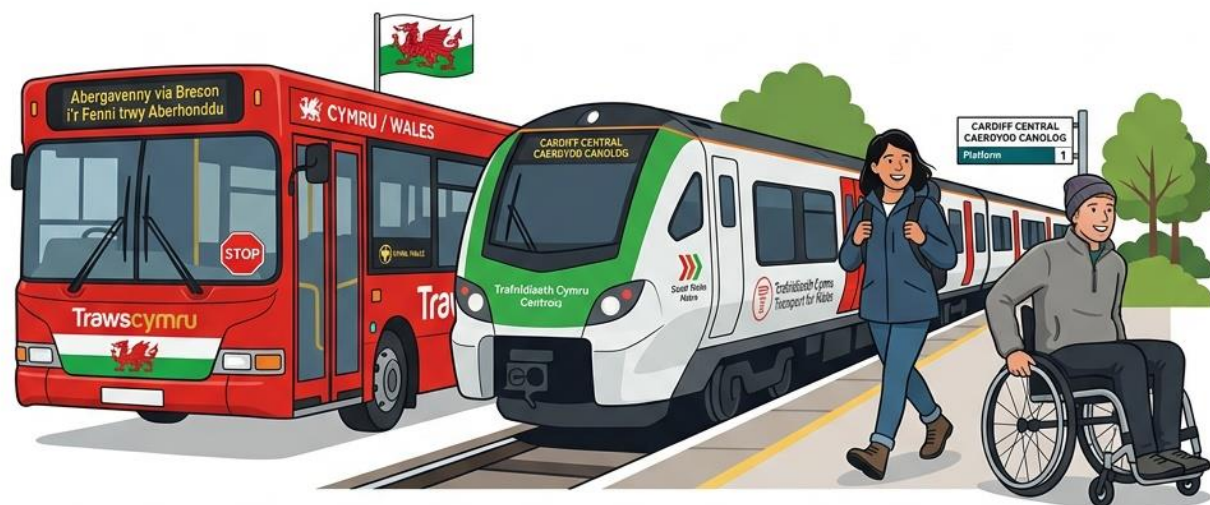

We will also run focus groups for young people who do not live in a city or large town. We will listen to people's experience of travelling.

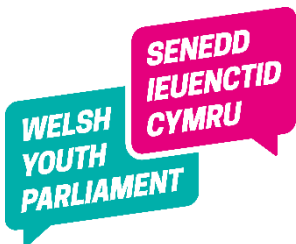

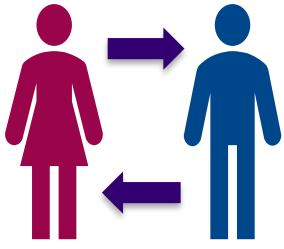

Mytravelpass: cheaper bus fares for 16- to 21-year-olds



Young person's £1 Bus fare scheme for 5- to 21-year-olds



Free train tickets for anyone under 11 years old, when they travel with an adult



Free train tickets for anyone under 15 years old, when they travel with an adult, at off-peak times



Family return train tickets: 2 people aged under 16 travel for free with an adult.
